A few days ago I had a dream about the Rapture. I am what Some People would call a Dreamer. I dream every time I go to sleep. Most all of them are not to be received as from the Lord, but I know when one is from Him. They always help me one way or another.

My recent dream about the Rapture was from the Lord and it has been a blessing to me. I will give Parts of it as follows: The Rapture was about to start and God had gathered His Bride together in the Spirit. I knew it was leaving time and that I was going up with them. (Dear Friends, don't think

it is wrong to know you are Bride and have Eternal Life)

As I looked around, it was as though I could see a great number of people who did not Seem to know what was happening. This knowledge caused a great Burden to come on my heart. I cried out to the Lord, "What about all these other People?" No answer came to me from the Lord while I was in the dream and I woke up

As I was fully awake and was still much concerned about the host of People who apparently were not going up, the Lord spoke to me about a statement His Prophet Br.

William Branham had made. It was concerning People who would receive Eternal Life and one reason why they would be saved.

I made a search of Br. Branham's sermons and found the quote in the message "The Rejected King" preached in Jeffersonville in May of 1960. Since some of you may not have this message, I want to put parts of it in this Sermon. It starts on Page 20 and goes through Page 23. Br. Branham said he could hear an old Song that goes like this "I am homesick and blue and I want to see Jesus; I would like to hear

those sweet harbor bells chime; It would brighten my path and would vanish all fears; Lord, let me look past the curtain of time.” Then he said “I heard something say, would you like to see just beyond the curtain?” He said back to the voice, “It would help me so much.” Then I looked and in just a moment, one breath, I’d come into a little place that slanted. I looked back and there I was laying on the bed. I said, “This is a strange thing.” He said, “It wasn’t like any vision I ever had---I never saw so many people come running, screaming, “Oh our Precious Brother.” And I looked, and young women, maybe in their early twenties (eighteen to twenty) they were throwing their arms around me and screaming, “Our Precious Brother.”

Quote: “The Rejected King” Page 21 “Here come young men in the brilliance of young manhood, and their eyes glistened and looking like stars on a darkened night,

their teeth white as Pearl, and they were screaming and grabbing me and screaming “Oh our Precious Brother.” And I stopped, looked, and I was young. I looked back at my old body laying there with my hands behind my head. I said, “I don’t understand this.” and these young women throwing their arms around me-----“

And I looked this way and that way and they were coming by the thousands-----And here come Hope, that was my first wife. She run and never said, “My Husband.” She said, “My Precious Brother.” And when she hugged me there was another woman standing there that’d hugged me and then Hope hugged this woman and each one----I thought this has to be something different, it can’t be, there’s something----oh would I ever want to ever go back to that old carcass again!

Page 22 “And then that Voice that was speaking

from above me said, “You know it is written in the Bible that the Prophets were gathered with their People,” and I said, “Yes I remember that in the Scripture.” It said, “Well this is when you will gather with your People.” I said, “Then they are real and I can feel them?” “Oh yes” I said, “But there’s millions, they’re not that many Branhams.” And that Voice said, “They’re not Branhams; them’s your converts. That’s the ones you’ve led to the Lord.”

Page 23 is where I want to get to the meat of this sermon. Quote: Just then a Voice said “All that you have ever loved and all that ever loved you, God has given to you here.” And I looked and here come my old dog, come walking up. Here come my horse and laid his head over on my shoulder and nickered. Said, “All that you ever love and all that ever loved you, God has given them into your hand through your Ministry.” (End of Quote)

When I woke up out of my dream, I was still burdened over so many apparently not going up. And this is when the Lord reminded me of what the Supernatural Voice had said to Br. Branham concerning those who would have Eternal Life. And I remembered the Scripture that declares that even a cup of cold water given to the cause of God will not lose its reward!!!

And then other Scriptures become much more meaningful to me, such as "Love your neighbor as yourself", and "Love your enemies" and how the Bible teaches that "Love Never Fails."

This writer believes that the Bride is now in the Time Period when that which is Perfect has come, speaking of The Love of God!!!

The apostle Paul testified that without God's Supernatural love in his heart, he was "Nothing"! He could move mountains, prophesy and understand many mysteries. He Fed

the poor and offered his body to be burned, but in the Final wind-up of his sermon is 1st Corinthians. 13:13, He said, "And now abideth Faith, Hope and Charity, (Love) these three, but the greatest of these *is* Charity."

Love is great and Powerful because when we have it for the lost we can bring them into the Kingdom by loving them!

Quote: "The Great And Mighty Conqueror" (Found in the Easter Revival Book) "That's what it takes! That's the Material that the Church has got. What a Weapon! There has never been one like it. He was the Word. And when He come, He was born in a manger. He come to use the Weapon of L-O-V-E, love, to conquer the world; not with army bullets, not with machine guns and tanks. But He come in a different manner.. He come in the form of Love. He was God's Love. (End Quote)

And so we conclude that with this revelation that God will give Eternal Life

to all we Ever loved, and
all who Ever loved us,
we have a better
understanding about those
who may not be Bride, but
who will have Eternal
Life.

Our mindset should

always be that God is not
trying to keep People out
of Heaven, but always
bring them in. We hear
plenty of Preaching about
What will keep us out of
Heaven, but we need more
about what will get us in.

As Br. Branham said,
“We have insurance that
will put our old bodies in
the grave, but we need
more Assurance that He
will bring us back out.”
