INTRODUCTION:

Spiritual Dynamite The revelation that God has said, (sworn) that He does not charge Sin to those who believes in Jesus Christ, this is what I am calling **Spiritual Dynamite**. Jesus said, “I did not come to condemn the world, but He came with a Plan to Save the world.”

He came to Pay the Sin debt that we owed, but could not Pay! He Paid the debt, which resulted in all true Believers being Sin Free in God’s mind.

Let’s read the Scripture:

John 3:16-20, 16 For God so loved the world, that He gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but

that the world through him might be saved.

18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. 20 For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reprov’d.

1 John 3:5-9, 5 And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin. 6 Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not; whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him. 7

Little children, let no man deceive you; he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous. 8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil. 9 Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

1 John 3:20-21, 20 For if our hearts condemn us, God is greater than our heart and knoweth all things. 21 Beloved if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God.

How many times have we read John 3; 16-17 and still continued to live

under condemnation because of our sins???? (May God help us to See) Let's study our text Scriptures and pray for revelation!

John 3:16, It says clear and plain that those who Believe on Jesus Christ and His Plan shall not perish!!!

It Promises that those people will have Eternal Life! It means that they will live forever.

In order for us to live forever we to be Sin Free! And God has Set before us His Holy Law in James 2:10 which says, "For whosoever shall keep the whole law and yet offend in one Point, he is guilty of all." (Guilty as if he had broken the whole law)

When God gave Moses the Holy Righteous Law, He knew that we who were born lost, (Born on death row so to speak)--- He knew we could never Keep all the Law all our life. This is because the Scripture says the Law Failed, not because it wasn't right and good, but because of the weakness of our Flesh, (Rom.8:3) **"For what the law could**

not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh." John 3:17

For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn it.

God Condemned Sin but He did not condemn the Sinner!!! All lost sinners who will repent and believe God's Plan---they are Justified Forever!

They have the Holy Ghost Seal that places them in Eternity.

Now we want to go down to the Meat of our Sermon!!! Although our text Says that "He that Believeth is not condemned, it does not say that He that believeth will not have his Faith tested and tried."

Our Faith will be exercised, because untried Faith can be just words spoken out of our intellect. Peter spoke of his own intellect and Said he was ready to die for the Lord, then denied Knowing Him in Pilate's Judgment Hall.

We need to understand that when God gives us some Faith, He fully

intends to test it to see what we will do with it.

Do we realize that when we ask for more Faith we are really asking for more trials also? But here is where so many of us make a mistake, we think we are being condemned or judged for our Sins!!! But the trial of our Faith is not condemnation! There will be many trials, but through it all we are still Justified!!!

If we have ever truly repented and asked for help to lay our Sins down, then we must receive the Holy Ghost! Our Faith may seem to be at a very low Place when the trial is long and hard-----but we are still not Condemned, because we hold in our heart the Fact that God will never Stop loving a repentant Believer.

God will chasten every Believer, but that is not Condemnation. We must remember our text that Says God does not condemn a Believer. Even when The Lord smites us and leaves a welt with every blow and some blood may flow, even then we are to know

that nothing can Change His Supernatural love for us. Even then we are still Not Condemned. Our Faith may get low at times when He is Breaking us, but we are still not under condemnation!

Our emotions go up and down like a window shade. Our emotions are affected by the Circumstances of life. Like the mercury in the thermometer goes up and down with the weather.

But God's love for His saved People is not changed by the Circumstances of life. We repent and keep walking and believing. A hundred devils swearing to a lie couldn't make it true and our doubts and fears are all lies!!!!

Rom. 8:33-39, 33 **“Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God’s elect? It is God that justifieth. 34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us. 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?**

shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 As it is written, FOR THY SAKE WE ARE KILLED ALL THE DAY LONG; WE ARE ACCOUNTED AS SHEEP FOR THE SLAUGHTER. 37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. 38 For I am persuaded that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

It is a lie from the devil that God has ever one time forsaken any of His People nor cast away an innocent Person. Now remember this Promise is for Believers! But you may say I am full of Sin, And all of us have Some, but our Sins were laid on Jesus before we were ever Born.

We may sin in some way every day, but it is no

longer our Sin, God has taken it away. This is because we are made righteous by our Faith in His Free Gift of Righteousness. (Rom. 5:17)

God will never forsake the Righteous. It may be that God will hide His Face from us temporarily and we may at times be in despair, but even this does not disprove our text, “He that will continue to believe is not Condemned.”

God that called us and saved us will not lose us. He has said, **“I, even I, am he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins.”** (Isa. 43:25)

King David went a long way away from God, but he was not lost. He came back and cried, “Have mercy on me, oh God.” And so will it be with every repenting Soul, God will bring us back. We may slip and be overcome by temptation, but God will bring His Chosen ones back and we will all meet at the Marriage Supper before long.

Our text Scriptures do not mean that God's People won't be tried---- they will be. Even if we backslide, we will not be Condemned, He will not erase our name out of His Book of Life.

His Father's heart yearns after us and He will Say, "Come back to Me, you are my Child and I have

chosen you, and I did not save you, then lose you down the road somewhere."

Rom. 8:1, **"There is therefore now no Condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit."** (Filled with the Holy Ghost and being

taught and led by the Holy Ghost)

We do well to remember that our Prophet said, "Rapturing Faith lays in these Messages." Soon, and very Soon, we will be needing that Faith. Come Quickly Lord Jesus and take us off of this Sin Cursed Earth!
